The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has reviewed the letter received February 26, 2026 requesting an extension of the time period, stipulated in MDE Stormwater Management and Sediment and Erosion Control Approval, dated March 6, 2023, for the referenced project in Cecil County.

Condition #1 of said Approval states: "This Approval shall become null and void if the construction authorized herein has not been completed within three (3) years from the granting of this Approval, the Approval shall become null and void except that these limits may be extended at the discretion of the Department. Extensions shall be requested by the owner or authorized agent."

The MDE hereby extends the completion date of Condition #1 to March 12, 2029.

Projects having a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Stormwater Associated with Construction Activity may need to extend term of permit.
