Upon staff recommendation, the Harford Soil Conservation Board of Supervisors approves the sediment control plan WOODLEY ROAD EXTENSION. The staff has reviewed and discussed this plan with the consulting engineers or developer and is familiar with the site. The practices to be installed are considered adequate to provide sediment control during construction.

Appropriate sediment control measures will be installed before grading, construction, etc. are started. Approval is limited to the site covered by this plan and the work proposed. Major changes in the project, or the inclusion of additional disturbed area require that a new or revised plan be submitted to the Harford Soil Conservation District.

District approval of this plan for sediment control in no way relieves the owner/developer of his responsibility to obtain all necessary permits from regulatory federal, state, and local agencies prior to construction.
