If the proposed work/construction activity changes or alters the FEMA 100-year boundaries or elevations, the Owner or his authorized agent shall be fully responsible for and required to contact FEMA and apply for a Conditional Letter of Map Amendment (CLOMR), which may necessitate a separate hydrologic and hydraulic study (determined by FEMA) before construction, and to complete the FEMA Amendment process with a Letter of Map Amendment or Revision (LOMR) after construction is completed. This includes coordinating and informing the local government/community.

8. **This approval is only for Phase 1 of the MSU O'Connell Hall project. Erosion and sediment control plans for the remaining phases of this project and the stormwater management construction details shall be submitted to MDE/WSA for review and approval. This approval shall become null and void if a subsequent submittal is not received within 90 days of this approval.**
